

Light Up Manatee:

Illuminating a Community Through Innovation and Collaboration



In 2024, a study by Manatee County and Florida Power & Light (FPL) found a shortfall of over 9,000 streetlights. With 90% of the county dark at night—and the worst-lit areas facing the highest crime rates—concerns about safety and quality of life grew urgent.

THE SOLUTION

Manatee County used \$3 million in American Rescue Plan funds to improve lighting in high-crime areas.

Streetleaf installed solar-powered streetlights in under-lit, low-income neighborhoods without existing infrastructure, saving the county thousands in installation costs and minimizing disruption.
